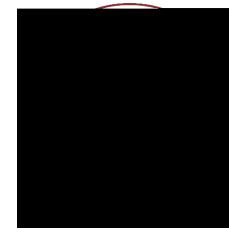

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COMMUNITY

Bay Shore is located in Suffolk County, approximately 42 miles east of New York City, on the Great South Bay of Long Island. It is primarily a residential suburban community of about 30,000, with a majority of business and professional residents. A recreational seaside area, Bay Shore also has well developed business and retail centers. The school district consists of one high school, one middle school, two intermediate schools, and three primary schools, with a total enrollment of approximately 5,925 students.

SCHOOL

Bay Shore High School (grades 9-12) is a comprehensive four-year College-Preparatory High School serving the areas of Bay Shore, Brightwaters, and Fire Island. The student body of about 1,900 students represents a diversity of backgrounds in culture, education, occupations, and income. The school has a professional staff of 185, and is accredited by the New York State Board of Regents.

CURRICULUM

Being an IB World School shows our community has the commitment to a high quality, challenging, international education that Bay Shore believes is important to all of our students.

In addition to required academic courses, Bay Shore High School offers a wide variety of elective programs in all subject areas. Advanced Placement courses are offered in English, Social Studies, Natural Sciences, World Language, and Mathematics. We have an extensive offering of Humanities, Multi-media and Law courses. Eleventh and twelfth-grade students have the opportunity of participating in an extensive vocational training program at nearby Board of Cooperative Education Services (BOCES) centers. Humanities is an interdisciplinary English, Social Studies, and Art course. Three credits are awarded upon completion of this intensive course each academic year. Students must apply for this very
