The Bay Shore Union Free School District provides a free breakfast and lunch meal for all students who are unable to pay for their meals. This policy is designed to ensure that all students have access to a safe and nutritious meal. The Food Service Department is responsible for providing these meals and for maintaining accurate records of meal accounts.

This policy is subject to change without notice. The Food Service Department reserves the right to modify this policy at any time. The Food Service Department is committed to providing a safe and nutritious meal for all students.

To comply with State guidelines and maintain a system for accounting for charged meals, regarding both full and reduced-price meals, the District shall:

1. allow only regular reimbursable meals, of the student's choice from that day's offerings to be charged, excluding extras, à la carte items, side dishes, additional

meals, snacks, and competitive foods, and

2. use a computer-generated point-of-sale system which identifies and records all
